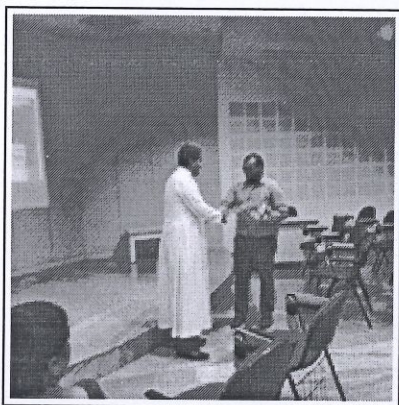


TRAINING SESSION ON "CLINICAL KEY"

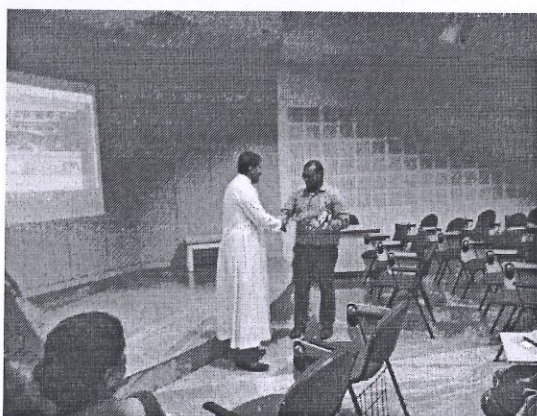


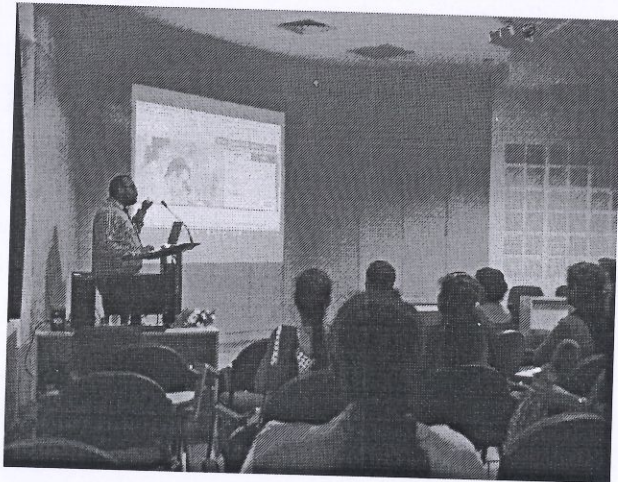

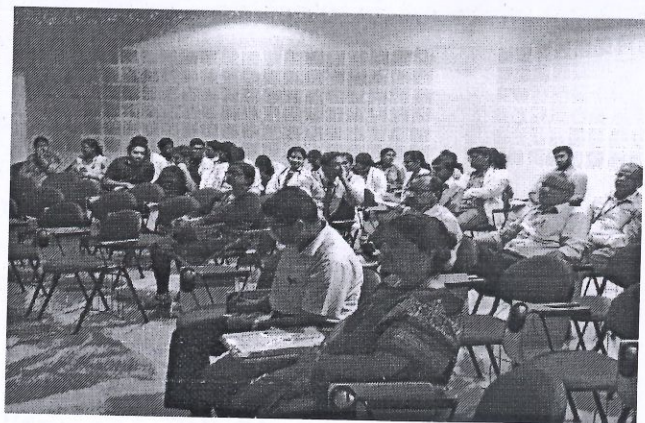
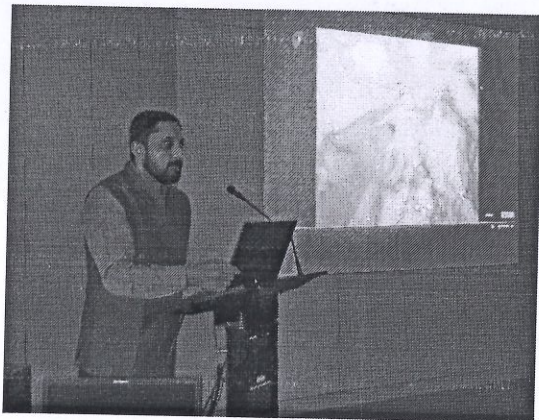
INCISION

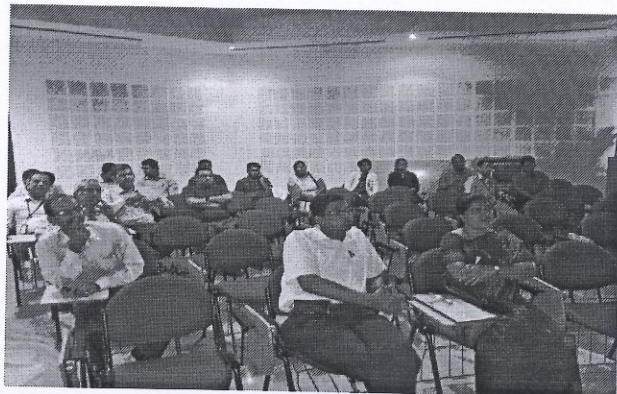
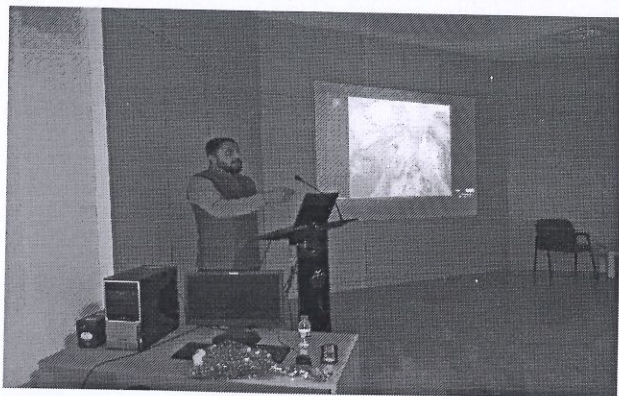
