

## Activities organized by the Research Innovation & extension Committee

On 18–19 October 2024, criteria III conducted a two-day training on AI tools jointly with the Research centre, the resource persons Mr. Royal Praveen Dsouza and Dr. Reji P—John from St. Aloysius University, Mangalore, which benefitted 40 participants.



2) On 30 September 2024, in collaboration with the FMCI Central Library, an orientation on e-resources was organized for 185 students of the 2024–25 batch, with Dr. Janet Dotty Lobo, Chief Librarian, as the resource person.
