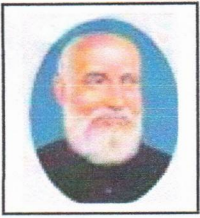
Each session emphasized practical application, analytical thinking, and collaborative problem-solving, enabling students to develop essential research skills in a supportive learning environment.

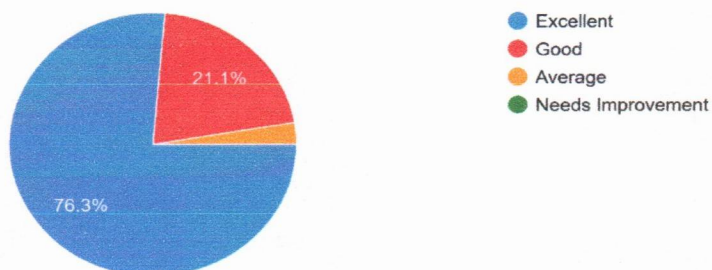

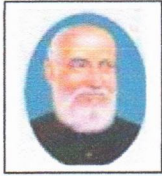

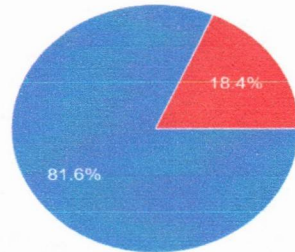
2. Clarity and structure of power point content

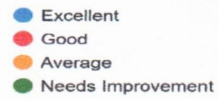
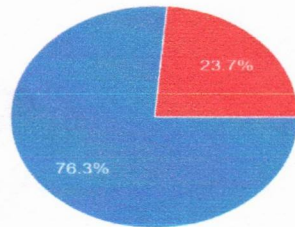
3. Effectiveness of teaching methods used

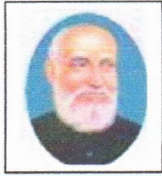

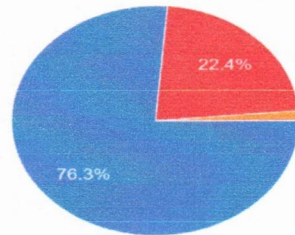

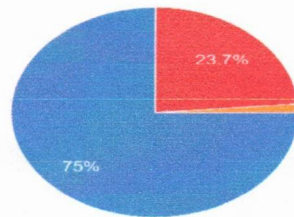

7. Comfort and suitability of the venue

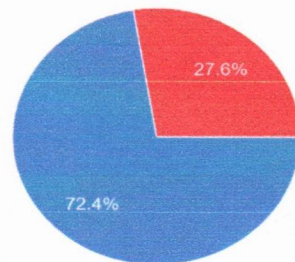

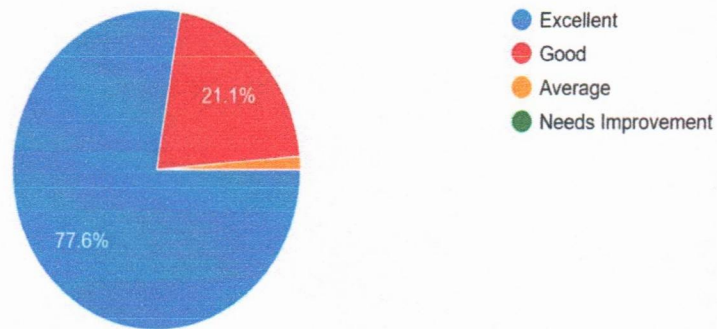

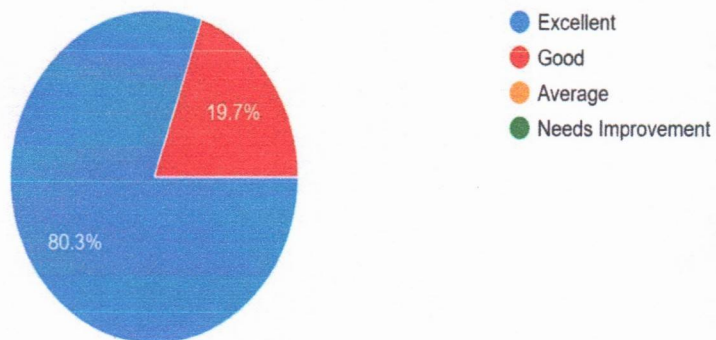
9. Usefulness of examples and practical insights shared

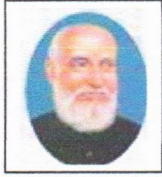
